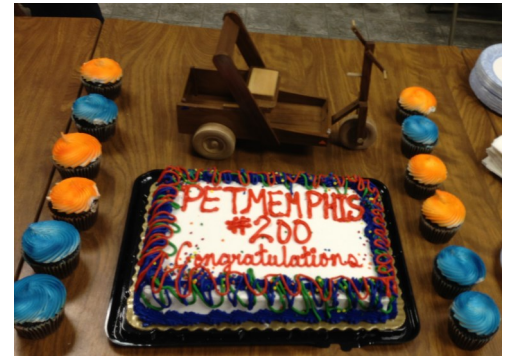

PET Build at United Methodist's Annual Conference



On the first week of June at Collierville, the United Methodist Church held its Memphis Annual Conference. At the conference, PET Memphis set up a shop in a class room where members of the conference delegations were able to receive hands-on information about the PET Project and find out about how they or their church could get involved in giving the Gift of Mobility.

The Asbury district, led by district superintendent Reverend Sandra Leatherwood Clay, was able to raise over \$2,500 to aid in funding the materials to build the ten PETs at the conference. This was made possible by consulting churches in her district.

These ten PETs will be a part of a shipment to the Dominican Republic in September. A mission team will be facilitating the distribution of these PETs in December.
