P.E.T. Distributions

September found us shipping 48 units to MedShare in Georgia for inclusion in their medical shipment to their sites.

In October we shipped 139 P.E.T.s to Vietnam. They will arrive in time for distribution during the time that members of D.O.V.E. (Development of Vietnam Endeavors) will be there in January 2015.



We also supplied 8 PETS to Lake Pointe Church in Rockwall, TX for distribution through their missions programs.

Another 6 PETs went to First United Methodist Church in Duncanville, TX. These PETs will be included in a container that has been built as a medical clinic and is being sent to Panama.

The San Antonio PET shop arranged for a shipment of PETs to Honduras in November, and the Brazos Valley supplied 21 units toward this shipment.

We are looking forward to receiving pictures and stories from future distributions.

Here is a riddle, who built P.E.T.s with the Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop tools before the volunteers in Bryan/College Station? The answer would be the United Methodist Men of FUMC La Grange. The next riddle would be, how was that possible? The UMM of La Grange first began working in the Luling P.E.T. shop in 2005. After hearing a presentation by the Luling volunteers, the UMM of La Grange made a commitment to visit the shop and build P.E.T.s once a month. In 2009, due to the health concerns of the Luling volunteers, the Luling shop moved to Bryan and became the Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop. The men of La Grange simply changed directions and continued their mission in the new Bryan shop. The UMM of La Grange have been working almost ten years providing mobility for people in need in developing countries.

The volunteers from La Grange do much more than volunteer once a month. Since 2007 they began purchasing 2 bundles of wood from the Bryan Lowes twice a year. They cut the wood to length, rip the necessary boards and shape them all before they arrive in Bryan. The UMM bring the cut lumber with them, use a few of our jigs to drill some hole, round over a few edges with the router and then assemble 6 P.E.T. s each month. From 2007 through 2013 they have provided the lumber and built 471 P.E.T.s!

The P.E.T. shop mission of the La Grange volunteers is funded by the United Methodist Men of FUMC La Grange. Twice a year they operate a commercial kitchen at the Blue Hills venue of the Round Top Antique Fair. For 15 days, twice a year, they serve BBQ plates, sandwiches, salads, wraps, baked potatoes, desserts and cold drinks to the visitors of the Antique Fair. This massive fund raiser, run by the Methodist men and community volunteers, provides funds for many of the UMM programs, including the lumber for the P.E.T.s

We recently received another gift from the UMM of La Grange. The Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop decided to purchase a very expensive new Saw Stop, a safety table saw that contains a cartridge that will automatically grab a moving blade and jerk it down below the table if the blade comes in contact with flesh. The men of La Grange graciously paid for one half of the saw, thus making the purchase possible.

The Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop is very grateful to the men of La Grange. The financial gifts, volunteer hours and great company are a blessing to us. Charlie Learned, Dr. Charles Ebel, Jim Kahlden, Orvel Hill, David Jenkins and Don Meek are an invaluable part of the Brazos Valley P.E.T. s

Arms of Mercy

Honduras

The Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop is currently building 50 P.E.T.s to be shipped to Honduras by our esteemed partner Arms of Mercy. Arms of Mercy began in 2005 in the Honduran city of San Pedro Sula. Two programs are the founding base of Arms of Mercy. The Integrated Management of Childhood Illness (IMCI) trains doctors, nurses and parents to help prevent the high death and illness rates among the Honduran children under 5. The Medical Ambassador's Community Health Education program helps communities identify and develop solutions within their communities. The program has over 1,000 training modules on issues such as health, nutrition, sanitation and microenterprises.

In 2006 Arms of Mercy began two new programs. The Moringa Nutrition Programs distributes a vitamin/mineral developed from the leaves of the Moringa tree. The leaves are reported to improve health and reduce illness.

Also in 2006 Arms of Mercy became a revered partner of the P.E.T. Project. Over 325,000 mobility impaired people live in Honduras. Arms of Mercy distributes P.E.T.s to even the remotest of villages. The P.E.T. helps Arms of Mercy to fulfill their mission: *Make a difference on a world in need through the seamless combination of disease prevention, education, and community development.*


