Wheatfield, IN — After five months of construction (July through November) the new PET workshop is ready to open its doors. When production halted in June we moved out of our first workshop, and all the work stations, supplies, inventory and equipment were put into storage until October 19

when volunteers excitedly moved everything into the new building.

Located almost around the corner from the first workshop, the 7200 sq. foot structure is across the street from the KV Intermediate School on CR 550 West.

Before, we were known as *PET DeMotte*, but now our address is Wheatfield.

As volunteers stopped by to check out the progress of

the building, they shared their excitement of having such a wonderful facility to accomplish their work. The work areas—welding, steel cutting & drilling, wood cutting & sanding, painting, assembly, and packing—are worker friendly, very bright, and well ventilated.

Thanks to many businesses and individuals, costs were kept very low; and there is only a need for an additional \$30,000 to make us debt

free! Praise God!

We are a 501(c)(3) organization, so all donations are tax deductible. We pray that many of you will be led to help retire that debt.

Myrta and Her PET Cart

Haiti -- May, 2010

Myrta had a hard life. Her legs are paralyzed and her husband abused her and left her with 3 children. Every morning her family members would take her outside and lay her under a tree all day, bringing her food when they had the time. She had no way of getting around. Workers with *Global Aid Network* gave her a wheelchair but there was no way she could push this wheelchair on the rough roads. Myrta had friends who would push her to church, but it was hard going; then she had to wait at church until someone would push her home. The gravel quickly wore out the tires of her wheelchair. ***Then she was given a PET cart and her life changed!*** When the *Global Aid Network* workers came back to Myrta's village, Myrta came pedaling as fast as she could across the gravel road to meet the American group. She shook hands with them all—huge smiles! And each Sunday, she now pedals the 1/2 mile to church on her own. **God's love was shown through the Gift of Mobility!**
