Brazos Valley P.E.T. Project has new distribution partners

The PET International Director of Operations, Von Driggs has developed a new distribution affiliate that is located in Texas. **Mercy Ships** (http://www.mercyships.org), has a warehouse / distribution center located in Lindale, TX. Ten units were delivered to their warehouse in June, with the anticipation that as these are sent to the ships and medical facilities operated by Mercy Ships, additional units will be needed.

Lake Pointe Church in Rowlett, TX has received six adult PETs from the Brazos Valley shop, and two childrens PETs from the PET shop in Michigan. These units are scheduled to be taken to Mexico by the Lake Pointe mission group later this summer. In working with their team in Mexico they have already identified several individuals that are in need of these units.

PET MO-Columbia set new shipment record last week!

June 25th "Last week was the biggest week of shipping on record. On Monday we shipped 40 PETs and 23 sewing machines to Mozambique. Wednesday we shipped a container of 212 PETs to Swaziland." PET MO-Columbia has a resolution to build 2012 PETs in 2012 which translates to 1000 built to date. The actual total to date is 1012!

NEW SHIPPING OPPORTUNITY

July 5, 2012

The Brazos Valley P.E.T. shop has been asked to send a 40 foot container of PETs to Dakar, Senegal.



We currently have 140 units available to be shipped. The distributing mission would like 200 units, or the number that we are able to get into a 40' shipping container.

Unlike most shipments where our responsibility is only to ship the units to the shipping port, in this instance we are being asked to pay for the shipping of the units from Bryan to Dakar, Senegal. We have today received the price quote from the shipping company. The cost will be approximately \$5,400.

We have some funds available to pay for this shipping; however any additional donations to help defray this cost would be appreciated.

The second item regarding this is physical assistance. Without paying additional shipping charges we are restricted as to the number of hours we may have the container on site to load it. At this time we do not have a day specified for loading the container, however we do anticipate that it will be late August. If there are any individuals or a group that might be interested in assisting, please contact us at our e-mail address. Each of the boxes weighs approximately 125 pounds, and they would like us to load the container within a 2 hour time period. It is quite likely that we will not be able to have them on pallets as shown in the pictures, but rather stacked individually in the container.
