Brazos Valley P.E.T. Project has shipped 162 PETs to Senegal

The PET International Director of Operations, Von Driggs put us in contact with Dialla Toure, who is associated with the ONG Ker-Yaakaar mission group in Senegal. The required documents were received during the PET International conference on September 14th. With the potential for a longshoreman's strike beginning the first of October it was essential that the shipment be made before then. Missionary Expediters of New Orleans did an outstand job of arranging for the container and loading before the end of September.

The PETs were completed in early August in anticipation of this shipment. A benefactor of the BV PET shop, allowed us to use space in his facility from then until the shipment was made.



Mr. Garrett also provided us with workers who loaded the container that was sent for the PETs. This was very beneficial as we were only allowed two hours to load the 40' container with the 162 PETs.
