

### Where did the carts go in 2017?

- \* 182 shipped to World Vision
- \* 90 shipped to United Missions in Nepal
- \* 74 shipped to Brother's Brother Ministry
- \* 150 to TOGO, Africa through His Healing Helping Hands Ministry (4 HIM)
- \* 144 carts loaded for Haiti in partnership with MH4H
- \* Upcoming shipment to Sierra Leone


These stories illustrate what a Mobility cart is all about, changing the lives of many. If you have given or volunteered in any way, claim these stories as your own.


