MOBILITY WORLDWIDE ESTABLISHES EAST AL-WEST GA AFFILIATE

Mobility Worldwide, an international humanitarian Christian charity that builds specialized wheelchair-carts for those living in the developing world, has officially established an affiliate operation in Phenix City, AL. Mobility Worldwide's international board of trustees formally approved the operation after local volunteers underwent the required training and follow-on inspections needed to manufacture Mobility Carts to exact specifications.

The Phenix City team, led by Sam Singer, will be building and shipping carts to various locations throughout the developing world where they will be distributed free of charge to those who are unable to walk due to injuries from landmines, disease or birth defects. Mr. Singer was also appointed president of the E AL/W GA Affiliate's board of directors. Singer is a member of Epworth United Methodist Church, Phenix City, AL and worked in the information technology industry before his recent retirement from Auburn University.

"It's an honor to lead this effort to help those who are unable to walk and live in remote communities throughout the developing world. The carts not only offer mobility in areas where it's tough to get around but they also provide dignity and allow a person to become a part of their community," Singer stated. "While we have a good starter team of volunteers, we could always use more people who are interested in working with wood and metal to manufacture more wheelchair carts."

"We continue on our aggressive path to ramp-up more manufacturing operations throughout the US and we're thankful that Sam Singer and his team took the lead in the establishment of Mobility Worldwide's 22nd affiliate, this time located in the East Alabama-West Georgia area," stated Scott Walters, Mobility Worldwide Executive Director. "We look forward to the production of more carts to help those in need throughout South America, Africa, the Caribbean, Asia and elsewhere," he said.
