
2018 Annual Report

Mobility Worldwide MO - Columbia's mission is to provide appropriate mobility for all of God's children in need. We seek to provide mobility first for those in greatest need and with the least resources in poor or underdeveloped countries.

A tax-exempt 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization supported by those who believe in its mission of mobility in the form of contributions from individuals, churches/clubs, and businesses (cash, discounted or free cart parts).

Total revenue for FY 2018 was \$512,065.

Total expense for FY 2018 was \$517,452. Program expense was \$457,454 or 88% (shop space and equipment, shipping, and reporting materials to tell the story). Management and general was \$51,471 or 10%. Fundraising expense was \$8,527 or 2%.
