## MOBILITY WORLDWIDE BUILDS 80,000<sup>TH</sup> Mobility Cart as it CELEBRATES THE 25<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF ITS FOUNDING

Mobility Worldwide, an international humanitarian Christian charity that builds specialized wheelchair-carts for those living in the developing world, recently celebrated the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its founding by handcrafting Mobility Cart #80,000. The commemorative Mobility Cart was made with parts provided by the 22 affiliate locations throughout the US. The organization celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary during its annual conference which was held in Austin, TX September 26-28, 2019. Attendees were also briefed on a new strategic plan approved by the board of trustees that calls for an expansion of its operations to better fulfill its vision of "ending immobility in the world".

The new strategy calls for the distribution of other mobility assistive devices such as crutches, leg braces, conventional wheelchairs, etc. in addition to its current catalog of Mobility Carts. Additionally, two new prototype models of Mobility Carts will be field tested with the goal of mass production in the near future. One prototype has a molded resin body while the other has a new style of hand-crank propulsion system which allows for smoother braking and increased speed.

"We are now on a bold new track to better fulfill our mission and help tens of thousands of people annually", John Rudd, board of trustees, said. "While we will continue to handcraft our traditional Mobility Carts, we are exploring ways to help many more people by enhancing our production methods and also collecting and distributing other devices that will provide mobility and more to people in need".
