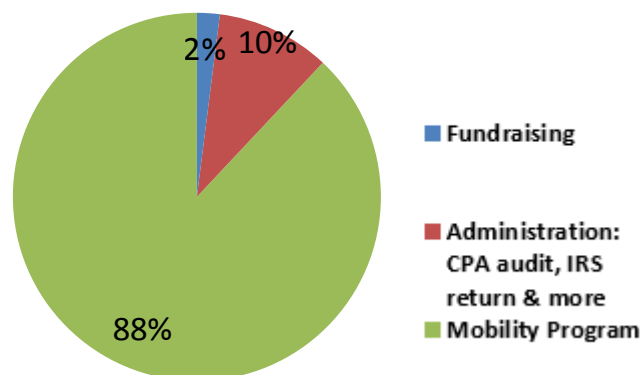
Total revenue for FY 2022 was \$892,599.

Program expense was \$692,633 or 88%
