Notes from the shop

We are proud to share that our 2025 goal of producing 168 carts was successfully reached in November.

Looking ahead, our 2026 goal is to build 180 carts. Each cart offers the gift of mobility and helps transform lives in meaningful ways, like the Leah's story above. To achieve this, the Mt. Lake shop will be engaging with churches and community organizations to expand our donor base and strengthen support.

Every cart we produce represents more than just transportation. It represents dignity, independence, and a brighter future for someone in need.

We once again joined forces with the Twin Cities Mobility Shop to ship carts to Uganda through the nonprofit Pathways to Hope Africa. Together, we sent a full container of more than 200 carts. Our Mt. Lake shop contributed 105 carts.
