Meet Macloud Baxton, 31, who faced numerous challenges due to mobility issues. Born healthy, his life was changed when he contracted cerebral malaria as a child. The illness left him paralyzed, limiting his mobility. Despite these challenges, Macloud discovered a passion for collecting and repairing bicycles.



Receiving a Mobility Cart brought hope and new opportunities for Macloud, who turned the cart into a mobile bike repair shop, allowing him to travel to his customers rather than waiting for them to come to him. Today, he attends church regularly and supports himself financially through his mobile repair business.

Macloud shared, "This cart has completely changed my life. I can now serve God, travel with ease, and support my community by fixing bicycles. My heart is full of gratitude for this ministry, which has restored my hope and reignited my purpose."
